Oven was automatically deemed to have final registration status as a Category II historic place under the transitional provisions of the Historic Places Act 1993 (HPA 1993). 2. REASONS FOR DISCONTINUING / REMOVING THE ENTRY FROM THE LIST

| Summary: | <p>The site is located near Puketapu in Palmerston, North Otago and was named for a tipuna who was a passenger on the Ārai-te-uru waka that capsized off Matakaea (Shag Point) on the Otago coastline. The tipuna Puketapu never returned to the waka after exploring inland and was transformed into this geological feature.¹</p> <p>Puketapu was identified as a kāika nohoaka (settlement) and kāika mahika kai (food-gathering place) by Merekihereka Hape during the 1879 Smith-Nairn Royal Commission of Inquiry into Kāi Tahu land claims.²</p> |

| | <p>At some point the initial identification as a raised rim pit was changed to midden/oven by the NZ Archaeological Association and it was described as an oven when registered by HNZPT.</p> <p>This site (J43/27) was visited by Dr Matthew Schmidt (archaeologist HNZPT) and Dr Tim Thomas (archaeologist, University of Otago) on 1 June 2018. They identified the correct location (see Figure 2) but there was no evidence of an archaeological site. The site may have been modified or destroyed. The whole surrounding area was thoroughly searched to ensure sites were not missed as a result of historic mapping conversion errors.</p> <p>The site has not been noted as having particular cultural importance in any of the web and written resources searched during this assessment.</p> |
| Reasons: | <p>The investigation into this place or area has indicated that it is not physically eligible for entry on the New Zealand Heritage List/Rārangī Kōrero ('the List') under the criteria defined in Section 66 of the Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga Act 2014. The request for removal is based on there being no physical evidence of the site at the location.</p> <p>For this reason, it is proposed that this place is removed from the List.</p> |
| Team and Manager Response: | <p>The Otago/Southland team and Area Manager were informed in August 2019 of the proposal to remove this place from the List and are in agreement that it should be removed. The Otago/Southland Pouarahi, Huia Pacey was consulted on 19 February 2020 and is in agreement with this assessment.</p> |

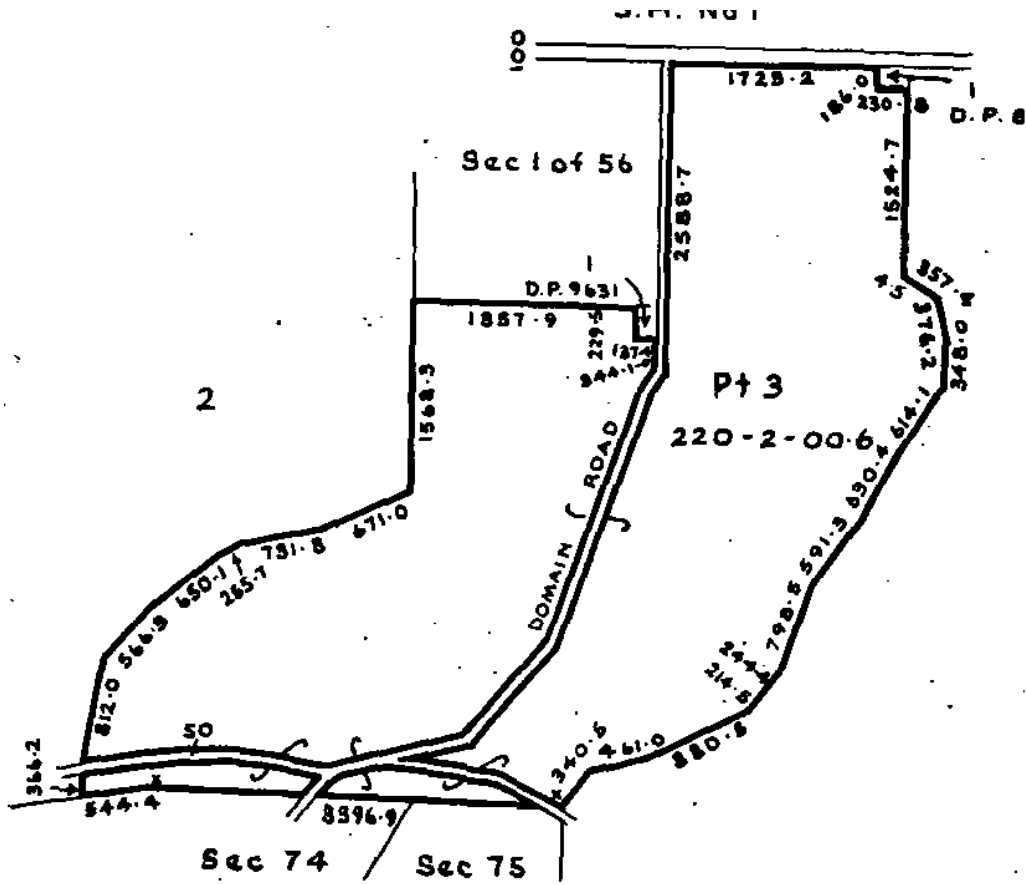
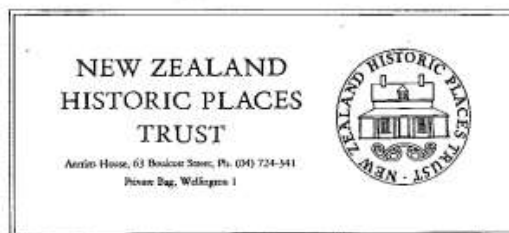


Figure 5: RT 500069

HISTORIC PLACES ACT 1980: REGISTRATION OF ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITE

1. The Historic Places Act 1980 requires the New Zealand Historic Places Trust to establish a Register of Archaeological Sites. Sites now being registered are selected from entries in the New Zealand Archaeological Association's site recording scheme but others will also be added as a result of future site location and recording programmes initiated or supported by the Trust.
2. The Act (Sections 43-48) extends its protection to all archaeological sites in New Zealand REGARDLESS OF WHETHER OR NOT THEY ARE REGISTERED. The act of registration places no additional duty or encumbrance on land owners or occupiers. Notification of registration is given to ensure an awareness of the presence of a site and the protection that the Act offers to archaeological sites.
3. You are now notified, under Section 43 of the Historic Places Act 1980, as owner/occupier of the land described as:

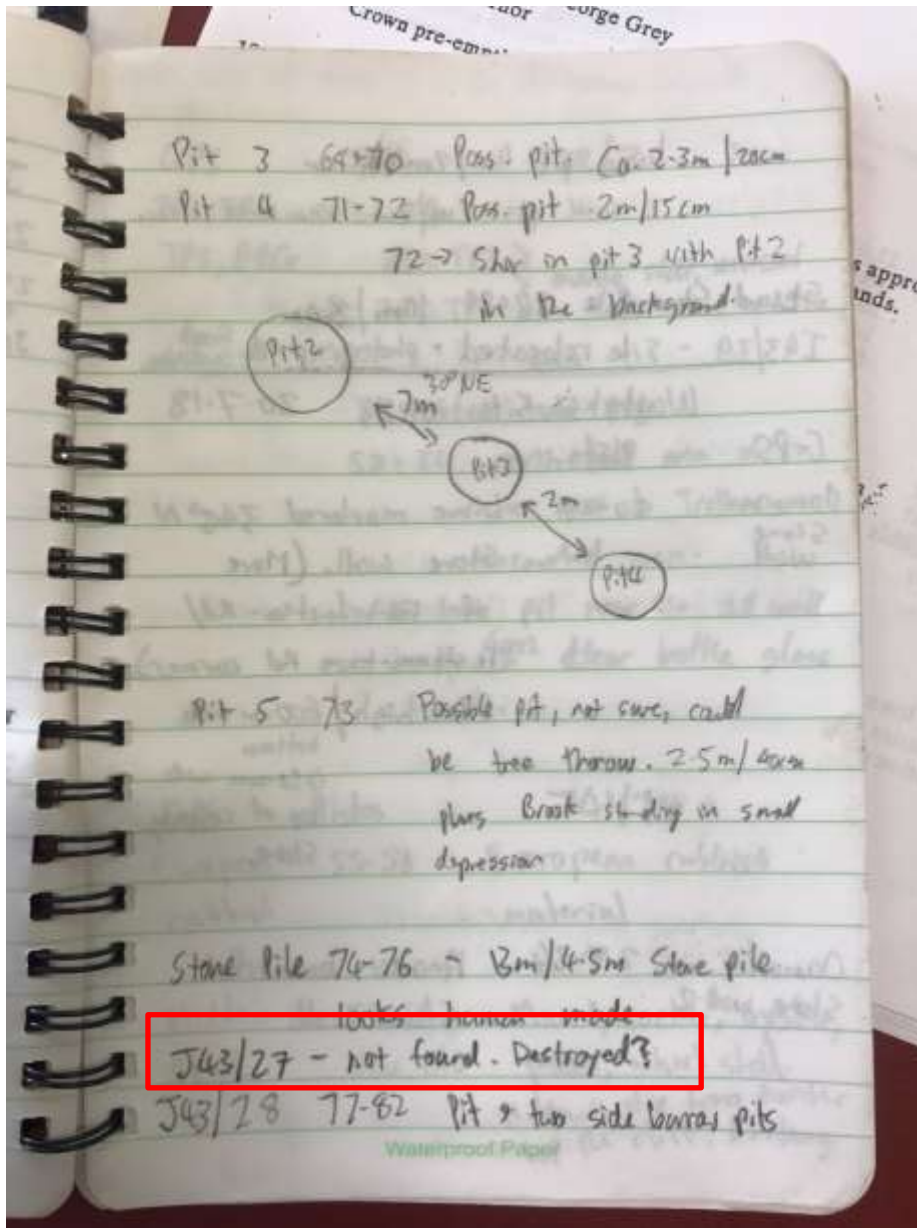


Figure 6: Excerpt from Dr Matthew Schmidt’s field book, 1 June 2018 showing recording of site J43/27
